Welcome to my Mat Decorating Workshop! This is a synopsis of what you will be learning and doing during this workshop, and a Supply List for the class.

Synopsis of Class:

- Coloring Bevels with Colored Pencils
- Coloring bottom mats with Colored Pencils or applying marbled paper
- Paper Cover 8 x 10 mats
- Spacers - lifting the mat off the artwork creating depth.
- French Matting – Gold Lines drawn on the mat to create the illusion of 2nd mat
- Problem Solving – Options, Fixes & Tools to help

Supplies provided by the Workshop

- Colored Pencils
- Gold Pens for French Lines
- Marbled Paper for French Matting
- Decorative Paper for Paper Covered Mats.
- Foam Core for Spacers
- ¼ " double stick tape.
- Post it Notes
- Handout
